## Pastoral Message

## The Lord Is Everything in Everything

As we're about to turn the corner between Thanksgiving and Christmas, I'm thinking of a phrase from scripture which describes the Lord. He is said to be "the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last."

When you stop to think about it, that's a pretty big statement. And when the theology of the New Church reflects on it, it says (many times over) that the Lord is the "all in all" (or the "everything in everything") of heaven and of the church on earth. In one place it says that to the angels of heaven, the Lord is "their all in all" (or, the Lord is "their everything in everything").

When you stop to think about it, that's a mind arresting teaching—the Lord is "everything in everything" of heaven and the church on earth. What does that mean? What is it saying? Is *that* what the Lord is to you and me – the everything in everything? And what are the implications for our daily choosing, and for our relationship and spiritual walk with Him?

One of the things this teaching reminds me of is the fact that the Lord is the source of all goodness and truth, all love and wisdom in marriage and relationships, all help and power in spiritual choosing, etc. He's even the one who fights our spiritual battles for us in times of spiritual conflict. The idea that the Lord is the everything in everything of heaven and the church seems to underscore how much we need to be looking to Him for everything we need, everything we receive in life, and every success we enjoy – spiritually, naturally, even physically.

As we turn the corner from Thanksgiving to the Christmas season, I invite you to ponder this teaching, and to realize that the little baby who was born in Bethlehem was and is the everything in everything of creation—the everything in everything of your life and mine.

I hope to preach on this topic sometime during the Christmas season. Happy Christmas to all. (Mark)
